All About the Classes

Instrument Loans

Instruments can be borrowed at any time, subject to a charge. The cost varies depending on the instrument as well its size, and ranges between 6 EUR and 30 EUR per month.

Class Locations

DORTMUND MUSIK.education offers classes in all twelve districts of the city. This means that classes may often be available at a location close to the pupil's home.

Social Discounts

Holders of the Dortmund-Pass receive a 50% discount on the tuition fees on presentation of appropriate documentation.

Family Discounts

If two or more people from the same family (parents and children) are taking classes, reduced tuition fees will apply. However, where two family members attend

classes from two different music offerings (DORTMUND MUSIK.education and the JeKits state programme), it will not be possible to grant a family discount. Also, it is not possible to receive both a social discount and a family discount at the same time.

Grants

In addition, the DORTMUND MUSIK.education Friends Association ("Förderverein") awards grants to support children's musical education.

Registration

Course registration is generally online, at: <https://anmeldung.musikschulverwaltung.de/dortmund>

However, it is also possible to submit registrations in writing.

Teaching Offers

Instrumental and Vocal Classes

Teaching is offered in small groups as well as individually or with a partner. Costs vary depending on the type and duration of the class.

Group Classes:

- 45 minutes per week with three to five participants, 39 EUR per month
- 30 minutes per week with two participants, 39 EUR per month
- 45 minutes per week, with two participants, 52 EUR per month

Individual Classes:

- 30 minutes per week – 69 EUR per month
- 45 minutes per week – 103 EUR per month

BiPa Orientation Year

Pupils changing from the JeKits state programme to the Music School section are given the opportunity to do an orientation year. This applies to children from the JeKits classes 1-4 for a period of one year from registration in the Music School section. The instrument will be provided free of charge.

Group Classes:

45 minutes per week with two participants,
42 EUR per month

Individual Classes:

30 minutes per week – 58 EUR per month

General Information Orchestra and Ensembles

DORTMUND MUSIK offers instrument players a variety of ways of playing their instruments together with other musicians. The orchestra offer is free to instrument pupils, while in all other cases, a charge

of 10 EUR per month is made for participation in orchestras, ensembles or bands.

Orchestra School

This is for pupils up to the age of 27 years who regularly take part in one or more DORTMUND MUSIK ensembles or orchestras. The offer applies to selected orchestras and is only for the instrument that the player is learning in the class.

Individual Classes:

- 45 minutes per week – 87 EUR per month
- 30 minutes per week – 58 EUR per month

Classes conclude with performances of what the pupils
have learned, presented across a variety of stages.

Musikfreizeit - Free-Time Music

Pupils from the age of 9 who have two years’ expe-
rience in playing their instruments are able to come
and play together with other musicians in an organised
free-time activity that takes place over a period of
several days. Free-time music activities conclude with
several performances.

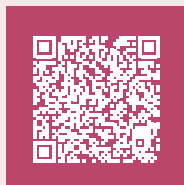
