

JeKits – Information on Instruments

Your child has discovered joy in music-making and would now like to learn to play the instrument of his/her choice?

If so, the most important information about participation in the JeKits programme can be found here and on jekits-dortmund.de.

Please note that participation in the programme is **voluntary** and is **subject to a tuition fee!**

Teaching programme

Instrument lessons are provided in groups, with joint playing in the “JeKits Orchestra”.

Instrument

The instrument is provided on loan, free of charge, for the duration of participation in the “JeKits” programme.

Costs

In the second year of participation in JeKits
€33.00 per month (annual fee €330.00, i.e. 10 x €33.00).

In the third and fourth year of participation in JeKits
€44.00 per month (annual fee €440.00, i.e. 10 x €44.00
(The tuition is provided in smaller instrument groups)

Exemptions

For recipients of

- benefits under SGB II (“Bürgergeld” [Citizen’s Income] and social benefit)
- benefits under SGB XII,
- housing benefit,
- supplementary child allowance,
- training/education allowance,
- benefits under the Asylum Seekers’ Benefits Act

participation in the “JeKits” programme is **free of charge**.

Education and Participation Package

It is possible to claim benefits under the Education and Participation Package.

Reduced rates for additional children

If two or more children from the same family take part in the JeKits programme, a 50% reduction is granted for the second and each further child.

The reductions are, however, only granted if corresponding documentary evidence is presented to DORTMUND MUSIK (Dortmund Music School).

Enrolment

The choice of instrument must be made at the same time as enrolment during the period from 17 March to 27 March.

Enrolment can be done online directly on the website.

A flyer containing all key information will be handed out during the JeKits I tuition session.

If necessary, you can also obtain an enrolment form in conventional paper format from your child’s JeKits teacher. At the time of enrolment, your child can name two instruments that he/she would most prefer to play. DORTMUND MUSIK will choose one of them for your child.

The decision on participation will lie with DORTMUND MUSIK. The date of the first teaching session will be made known in good time before the start of tuition.

You can cancel the enrolment within 14 days, with no need to give reasons. The period for cancellation will end 14 days after commencement of the tuition.

The enrolment is valid until the end of the child's primary schooling.

Cancellation

Cancellation is possible at the end of the respective school half-year as well as at the end of the school year (31 July) and must be made in writing to DORTMUND MUSIK by 30 November or 31 May, respectively.
