Commissioned by the city, each has its own story while collectively they take you on a journey through the various artistic movements of the past 150 years. The Department of Public Art maintains this diverse and vibrant collection, researching and preserving the works, enlarging the collection with permanent and temporary pieces, as well as providing mediation and outreach services.

The website features an extensive database of all artworks in public spaces owned by the City of Dortmund.













The Dortmund Nature Museum showcases the region's natural environment from its geological origins to the present day. Embark on a journey through the region, exploring a variety of habitats with their fauna and flora. Encounter giant ammonites, dinosaurs and a mammoth on your stroll through the history of the earth. The exhibition focuses on staging, with a host of original objects exhibited alongside dioramas and interactive media stations that invite the visitor to get involved and discover with all their senses. Special exhibitions covering national and global themes round off the collection.

The Hoesch Museum presents Dortmund's 160-year history of iron and steel in a historic setting. In the porter's lodge of the listed Westfalenhütte, exhibits relating to work and everyday life illustrate how the steel industry shaped the region. Themes are accompanied by multimedia and a 3D model of the steelworks, as well as temporary exhibitions. Its location at the original factory site nestled among trees, an educational trail and a host of other large-scale exhibits make for a well-rounded day out.



The permanent exhibition in the Hansa Brewery's old machine house is dedicated to the history of brewing in Dortmund, once the beer capital of Europe. It is situated in the grounds of the Dortmunder Actien Brewery, one of the largest breweries in Germany. Every first and third Thursday of the month, you can round off your visit to the museum with a tasting session in the historical brewhouse.

Library of the German Cookbook Museum

The cookbook library is a place for anyone interested in nutrition and food culture. The collection can be viewed and used during opening times. More than 12,000 books and leaflets spanning 250 years of cooking, housekeeping and education are available for research. Lectures and workshops dedicated to culinary and cultural history explore new possibilities for reestablishing the German Cookbook Museum. Suggestions for collaborative projects are very welcome!

The Westphalian School Museum was founded in 1910 as an institution for teacher training and as an exhibition of teaching materials. Today, it houses one of the most significant school history collections in Germany. It is to close in January 2025 for extensive renovation work that is expected to last for several years. During the refurbishment, the permanent exhibition is to be expanded substantially, offering an even more comprehensive insight into the history of schools and education. Some programs will continue to take place, including the mobile "museum briefcase". Further information is available on the website and on social media.

The Steinwache is one of the largest Nazi memorials in North Rhine-Westphalia. More than 66,000 people were sent to this former police prison during the National Socialist era. Some were executed by the Gestapo, while many more were sent on from here to concentration camps. The museum is to close at the end of May 2025 for long-term renovation work. Events and educational formats will continue to be offered at other locations. Current information is available on the website and on social media.

Municipal Gallery Gatehouse at Rombergpark

The gatehouse of the moated castle in Brünninghausen, now called "Torhaus Rombergpark" and built in 1681, has been home to the municipal gallery since 1968. Besides exhibitions organized by Dortmund's two artists' associations and local professional associations, the gallery also presents a variety of exhibitions by Dortmund artists' collectives as well as local artists and university graduates, often with an international focus and a participatory nature. All works on display can also be seen in a virtual 360° exhibition at torhaus-rombergpark.de.


